Detective

- 1. Gather your group in a large, open space. Have them stand 2m away from each other.
- 2. Invite one person to act as the 'Detective' and ask them to leave the space or close their eyes so that they do not witness what's about to happen next.
- DETECTIVE
- 3. Ask a second person to volunteer to become the 'Leader.'
- 4. When ready, ask your group to start walking randomly about the area.
- 5. At the same time, ask the Leader to start making specific and deliberate moves, inviting the rest of your group to copy their moves as quickly and accurately as possible.
- 6. At this point, ask the Detective to return to the space (or open their eyes) and begin to observe the group.
- 7. Encourage the Leader to change their moves or actions frequently, ie every 10 seconds or so.
- 8. Over the course of the next minute or two, challenge the Detective to identify the Leader within 4 attempts.
- Once the Leader has been identified, choose a new Leader and Detective to play a new round.
- 10. Continue play for many rounds.
